

Wholesale Trade, December 2021 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – February 16, 2022

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for December 2021 was \$10.4 million. This represents a decrease of \$2.5 million, or 19.3%, compared to December 2020, and a decrease of \$6.0 million, or 36.6%, compared to November 2021.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in December 2021 increased 13.9% compared to December 2020, and decreased 5.1% compared to November 2021.

On a year-to-date basis (January to December), wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$199.8 million. This represents an increase of \$46.8 million, or 30.6%, compared to the same time period in 2020 (\$153.0 million). Canada's year-to-date wholesale sales increased 14.4% over this time period.
