Wholesale Trade, February 2022 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – April 14, 2022

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for February 2022 was \$12.9 million. This represents an increase of \$811,000, or 6.7%, compared to February 2021, and an increase of \$198,000, or 1.6%, compared to January 2022.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in February 2022 increased 15.4% compared to February 2021, and increased 0.8% compared to January 2022.

On a year-to-date basis (January to February 2022), wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$25.6 million. This represents an increase of \$3.6 million, or 16.2%, compared to the same time period in 2021 (\$22.0 million). Canada's year-to-date wholesale sales increased 14.9% over this time period.
