

Wholesale Trade, June 2022 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – August 15, 2022

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for June 2022 was \$24.9 million. This represents an increase of \$7.7 million, or 44.8%, compared to June 2021, and a decrease of \$0.9 million, or 3.5%, compared to May 2022.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in June 2022 increased 12.3% compared to June 2021, and increased 0.6% compared to May 2022.

On a year-to-date basis (January to June 2022), wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$110.8 million. This represents an increase of \$14.8 million, or 15.4%, compared to the revised figure for the same time period in 2021 (\$96.0 million). Canada's year-to-date wholesale sales increased 13.6% over this time period.
