Wholesale Trade, March 2022 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada - May 16, 2022

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for March 2022 was \$16.8 million. This represents a decrease of \$3.1 million, or 15.6%, compared to March 2021, and an increase of \$3.7 million, or 28.6%, compared to February 2022.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in March 2022 increased 13.0% compared to March 2021, and increased 25.5% compared to February 2022.

On a year-to-date basis (January to March 2022), wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$42.6 million. This represents a decrease of \$592,000, or 1.4%, compared to the revised figure from the same time period in 2021 (\$43.2 million). Canada's year-to-date wholesale sales increased 15.0% over this time period.
