

Wholesale Trade, May 2022 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – July 15, 2022

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for May 2022 was \$26.0 million. This represents an increase of \$5.6 million, or 27.1%, compared to May 2021, and an increase of \$8.3 million, or 46.6%, compared to April 2022.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in May 2022 increased 15.1% compared to May 2021, and increased 8.3% compared to April 2022.

On a year-to-date basis (January to May 2022), wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$86.1 million. This represents an increase of \$7.3 million, or 9.3%, compared to the revised figure from the same time period in 2021 (\$78.8 million). Canada's year-to-date wholesale sales increased 14.0% over this time period.
