



Wholesale Trade, November 2021 *(preliminary)*

Released by Statistics Canada – January 19, 2022

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for November 2021 was \$16.8 million. This represents an increase of \$7.0 million, or 70.9%, compared to November 2020, and a decrease of \$1.6 million, or 8.8%, compared to October 2021.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in November 2021 increased 16.2% compared to November 2020, and increased 4.1% compared to October 2021.

On a year-to-date basis (January to November), wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$189.8 million. This represents an increase of \$49.7 million, or 35.5%, compared to the same time period in 2020 (\$140.1 million). Canada's year-to-date wholesale sales increased 14.5% over this time period.
