

Wholesale Trade, October 2021 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – December 16, 2021

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for October 2021 was \$18.3 million. This represents an increase of \$6.1 million, or 50.0%, compared to October 2020, and an increase of \$292,000, or 1.6%, compared to September 2021.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in October 2021 increased 5.9% compared to October 2020, and increased 0.2% compared to September 2021.

On a year-to-date basis (January to October), wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$172.9 million. This represents an increase of \$42.6 million, or 32.7%, compared to the same time period in 2020 (\$130.3 million). Canada's year-to-date wholesale sales increased 14.2% over this time period.
