

Retail Trade, July 2022 (preliminary)

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The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of retail sales in Yukon for July 2022 was \$97.7 million, an increase of \$7.9 million, or 8.8%, compared to \$89.8 million for July 2021. July 2022 retail sales decreased by \$5.5 million, or 5.4%, compared to June 2022.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 6.1% in July 2022 compared to July 2021, and decreased 4.8% compared to June 2022.

On a year-to-date basis (January through July 2022), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$580.2 million. This represents an increase of \$34.4 million, or 6.3%, compared to the same time period in 2021 (\$545.8 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales increased 9.2% over this time period.
