



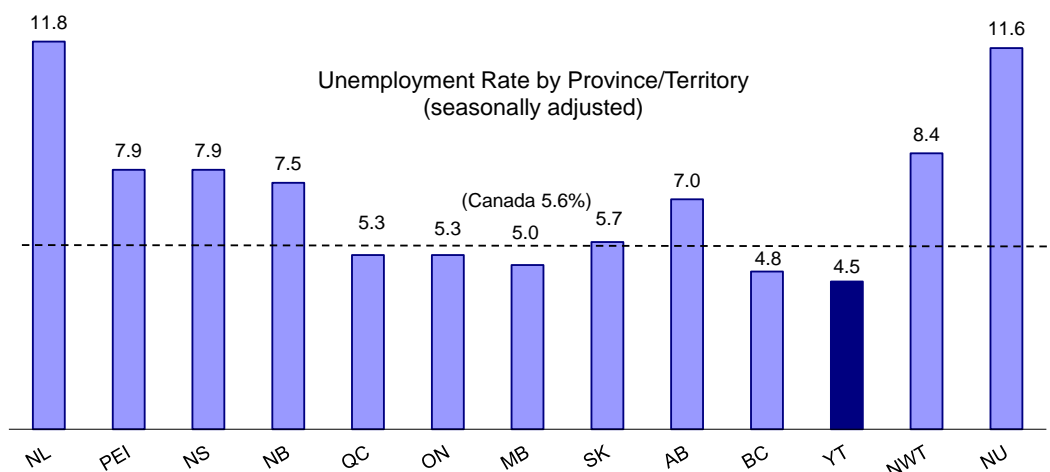
## Labour Force Survey, December 2019

Released by Statistics Canada — January 10, 2020

In December 2019, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 4.5%. Canada's unemployment rate for December was 5.6%. Compared to the figures for November 2019, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (22,200) decreased by 200; the number of employed (21,100) decreased by 400; and the number of unemployed (1,000) increased by 100.
