



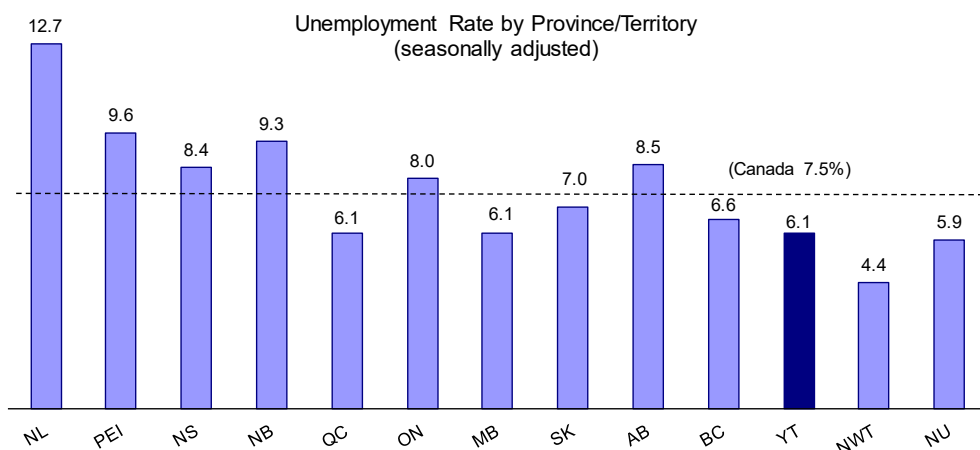
Labour Force Survey, July 2021

Released by Statistics Canada – August 6, 2021

In July 2021, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 6.1%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 7.5%. Compared to the figures for June 2021, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (23,000) decreased by 500; the number of employed (21,600) decreased by 200; and the number of unemployed (1,400) decreased by 200.
