
## Labour Force Survey, October 2021

Released by Statistics Canada - November 5, 2021

In October 2021, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 5.1%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 6.7%. Compared to the figures for September 2021, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (23,700) increased by 600; the number of employed (22,500) increased by 800; and the number of unemployed (1,200) decreased by 200.
