Retail Trade, April 2021 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada - June 23, 2021

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) for retail sales in Yukon for April 2021 was \$74.8 million, an increase of \$16.4 million, or 28.1%, compared to April 2020. Yukon's April 2021 retail sales decreased by \$122,000, or 0.2%, compared to March 2021.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 58.7% in April 2021 compared to April 2020 and decreased 2.6% compared to March 2021.

On a year-to-date basis (January through April 2021), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$275.5 million. This represents an increase of \$34.0 million, or 14.1%, compared to the same time period in 2020 (\$241.5 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales increased 21.2% over this time period.
