

Retail Trade, April 2022 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – June 21, 2022

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) for retail sales in Yukon for April 2022 was \$78.6 million, an increase of 2.2 million, or 2.8%, compared to \$76.4 million for April 2021. April 2022 retail sales decreased by \$1.8 million, or 2.2%, compared to March 2022.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 8.9% in April 2022 compared to April 2021, and increased 2.7% compared to March 2022.

On a year-to-date basis (January through April 2022), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$287.4 million. This represents an increase of \$6.8 million, or 2.4%, compared to the same time period in 2021 (\$280.5 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales increased 7.9% over this time period.
