



Retail Trade, August 2021 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada - October 22, 2021

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) for retail sales in Yukon for August 2021 was \$87.4 million, an increase of \$5.4 million, or 6.6%, compared to August 2020. Yukon's August 2021 retail sales decreased by \$703,000, or 0.8%, compared to July 2021.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 8.5% in August 2021 compared to August 2020 and decreased 1.7% compared to July 2021.

On a year-to-date basis (January through August 2021), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$625.3 million. This represents an increase of \$59.8 million, or 10.6%, compared to the same time period in 2020 (\$565.5 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales increased 15.1% over this time period.
