

Retail Trade, January 2021 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – March 19, 2021

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) for retail sales in Yukon for January 2021 was \$63.9 million, an increase of \$5.7 million, or 9.9%, compared to January 2020. January 2021 retail sales decreased by \$17.8 million, or 21.8%, compared to December 2020.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) decreased 1.1% in January 2021 compared to January 2020, and decreased 23.8% compared to December 2020.

On a **revised** annual basis, retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$892.3 million in 2020. This represents an increase of \$26.8 million, or 3.1%, compared to 2019 (\$865.4 million). Canada's annual retail sales decreased 1.4% over this time period.
