

Retail Trade, June 2020 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – August 21, 2020

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) for retail sales in Yukon for June 2020 was \$81.4 million, a decrease of \$554,000, or 0.7%, compared to June 2019. The June 2020 retail sales figure increased by \$5.7 million, or 7.5%, compared to May 2020.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 4.8% in June 2020 compared to June 2019, and increased 20.2% compared to May 2020.

On a year-to-date basis (January through June), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$400.7 million. This represents a decrease of \$8.4 million, or 2.1%, compared to the same time period in 2019 (\$409.1 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales decreased 8.3% over this time period.
