**Retail Trade, March 2021 (preliminary)**

Released by Statistics Canada – May 21, 2021

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) for retail sales in Yukon for March 2021 was \$75.0 million, an increase of \$8.3 million, or 12.5%, compared to March 2020. Yukon's March 2021 retail sales increased by \$12.9 million, or 20.8%, compared to February 2021.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 27.5% in March 2021 compared to March 2020, and increased 24.9% compared to February 2021.

On a year-to-date basis (January through March 2021), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$200.8 million. This represents an increase of \$17.7 million, or 9.7%, compared to the same time period in 2020 (\$183.1 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales increased 10.7% over this time period.
