



Retail Trade, May 2020 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – July 21, 2020

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) for retail sales in Yukon for May 2020 was \$75.8 million, a decrease of \$6.2 million, or 7.6%, compared to May 2019. The May 2020 retail sales figure increased by \$16.6 million, or 28.0%, compared to April 2020.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) decreased 20.0% in May 2020 compared to May 2019, and increased 32.4% compared to April 2020.

On a year-to-date basis (January through May), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$319.4 million. This represents a decrease of \$7.8 million, or 2.4%, compared to the same time period in 2019 (\$327.1 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales decreased 11.8% over this time period.
