

Retail Trade, November 2020 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada - January 22, 2021

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) for retail sales in Yukon for November 2020 was \$75.7 million, an increase of \$8.1 million, or 11.9%, compared to November 2019. The November 2020 retail sales figure decreased by \$7.2 million, or 8.7%, compared to October 2020.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 4.2% in November 2020 compared to November 2019, and decreased 2.1% compared to November 2020.

On a year-to-date basis (January through November), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$810.7 million. This represents an increase of \$14.7 million, or 1.9%, compared to the same time period in 2019 (\$796.0 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales decreased 1.9% over this time period.
