



Retail Trade, October 2019 (*preliminary*)

Released by Statistics Canada — December 20, 2019

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) for retail sales in Yukon for October 2019 was \$78.2 million, an increase of \$7.7 million, or 11.0%, compared to October 2018. The October 2019 retail sales figure increased by \$3.3 million, or 4.3%, compared to September 2019.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 0.2% in October 2019 compared to October 2018, and increased 2.6% compared to September 2019.

On a year-to-date basis (January to October), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$726.7 million. This represents an increase of \$26.8 million, or 3.8%, compared to the same time period in 2018 (\$699.8 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales increased 1.5% over this time period.
