



Retail Trade, October 2020 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – December 18, 2020

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) for retail sales in Yukon for October 2020 was \$81.3 million, an increase of \$5.8 million, or 7.7%, compared to October 2019. The October 2020 retail sales figure increased by \$145,000, or 0.2%, compared to September 2020.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 8.2% in October 2020 compared to October 2019, and increased 1.9% compared to September 2020.

On a year-to-date basis (January through October), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$733.4 million. This represents an increase of \$5.1 million, or 0.7%, compared to the same time period in 2019 (\$728.4 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales decreased 2.5% over this time period.
