



Retail Trade, September 2021 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – November 19, 2021

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) for retail sales in Yukon for September 2021 was \$82.5 million, an increase of \$1.9 million, or 2.4%, compared to September 2020. Yukon's September 2021 retail sales decreased by \$3.9 million, or 4.5%, compared to August 2021.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 4.1% in September 2021 compared to September 2020 and decreased 1.9% compared to August 2021.

On a year-to-date basis (January through September 2021), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$706.7 million. This represents an increase of \$60.7 million, or 9.4%, compared to the same time period in 2020 (\$646.0 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales increased 13.6% over this time period.
