

Registered Retirement Savings Plan Contributions, 2018

Released by Statistics Canada — February 18, 2020

In 2018, 21.9% of all Canadians taxfilers contributed to RRSPs. The number of contributors increased by 0.6% compared to 2017, and the amount of contributions increased by 3.6%. The median RRSP contribution in Canada for 2018 was \$3,130.

In Yukon, 24.7% of all taxfilers contributed to RRSPs in 2018. Compared to 2017, the number of contributors increased by 0.1%, however, the amount of contributions decreased by 2.2%. The median RRSP contribution in Yukon was \$3,470. Yukon's median contribution was the fourth-highest among all provinces and territories. Nunavut's median contribution was the highest at \$3,740, followed by British Columbia at \$3,680 and Newfoundland at \$3,500.
