



Wholesale Trade, April 2021 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – June 16, 2021

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for April 2021 was \$15.1 million. This represents an increase of \$2.9 million, or 24.0%, compared to April 2020, and a decrease of \$4.2 million, or 21.9%, compared to March 2021.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in April 2021 increased 46.8% compared to April 2020, and decreased 4.2% compared to March 2021.

On a year-to-date basis (January to April), wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$56.4 million. This represents an increase of \$11.7 million, or 26.1%, compared to the same time period in 2020 (\$44.7 million). Canada's year-to-date wholesale sales increased 16.4% over this time period.
