



Wholesale Trade, August 2021 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – October 15, 2021

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for August 2021 was \$20.1 million. This represents an increase of \$5.9 million, or 41.9%, compared to August 2020, and an increase of \$503,000, or 2.6%, compared to July 2021.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in August 2021 increased 9.9% compared to August 2020, and increased 1.2% compared to July 2021.

On a year-to-date basis (January to August), wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$136.9 million. This represents an increase of \$34.4 million, or 33.5%, compared to the same time period in 2020 (\$102.5 million). Canada's year-to-date wholesale sales increased 16.3% over this time period.
