

Wholesale Trade, December 2019 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada — February 24, 2020

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for December 2019 was \$8.5 million. This represents a decrease of \$1.6 million, or 15.9%, compared to December 2018, and an increase of \$1.5 million, or 20.7%, compared to November 2019.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in December 2019 increased 4.1% compared to December 2018, and decreased 4.9% compared to November 2019.

On a preliminary annual basis, wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$151.2 million. This represents a decrease of \$52.6 million, or 25.8%, compared to 2018 (\$203.7 million). Canada's annual wholesale sales increased 2.2% over this time period.
