

Wholesale Trade, December 2020 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – February 12, 2021

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for December 2020 was \$12.9 million. This represents an increase of \$3.8 million, or 42.3%, compared to December 2019, and an increase of \$3.0 million, or 30.3%, compared to November 2020.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in December 2020 increased 7.1% compared to December 2019, and decreased 4.2% compared to November 2020.

On a year-to-date basis (January to December), wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$160.7 million. This represents an increase of \$7.0 million, or 4.6%, compared to the same time period in 2019 (\$153.7 million). Canada's year-to-date wholesale sales decreased 1.0% over this time period.
