Wholesale Trade, February 2020 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada — April 20, 2020

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for February 2020 was \$9.0 million. This represents an increase of \$2.0 million, or 28.4%, compared to February 2019, and an increase of \$881,000, or 10.8%, compared to January 2020.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in February 2020 increased 6.2% compared to February 2019, and decreased 1.4% compared to January 2020.

On a year-to-date basis (January to February), wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$17.2 million. This represents an increase of \$2.4 million, or 15.9%, compared to the same time period in 2019 (\$14.8 million). Canada's year-to-date wholesale sales increased 4.4% over this time period.
