

Wholesale Trade, February 2021 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – April 16, 2021

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for February 2021 was \$11.4 million. This represents an increase of \$2.1 million, or 23.0%, compared to February 2020, and an increase of \$1.5 million, or 14.8%, compared to January 2021.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in February 2021 increased 4.2% compared to February 2020, and increased 0.6% compared to January 2021.

On a year-to-date basis (January to February), wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$21.3 million. This represents an increase of \$3.5 million, or 19.3%, compared to the same time period in 2020 (\$17.9 million). Canada's year-to-date wholesale sales increased 3.4% over this time period.
