

Wholesale Trade, July 2020 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – September 18, 2020

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for July 2020 was \$15.8 million. This represents a decrease of \$77,000, or 0.5%, compared to July 2019, and a decrease of \$734,000, or 4.4%, compared to June 2020.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in July 2020 increased 1.0% compared to July 2019, and decreased 1.8% compared to June 2020.

On a year-to-date basis (January to July), wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$91.3 million. This represents a decrease of \$4.2 million, or 4.4%, compared to the same time period in 2019 (\$95.5 million). Canada's year-to-date wholesale sales decreased 5.2% over this time period.
