



## Wholesale Trade, July 2021 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada - September 16, 2021

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for July 2021 was \$23.9 million. This represents an increase of \$9.4 million, or 64.4%, compared to July 2020, and an increase of \$3.1 million, or 15.0%, compared to June 2021.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in July 2021 increased 5.6% compared to July 2020, and decreased 10.3% compared to June 2021.

On a year-to-date basis (January to July), wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$121.0 million. This represents an increase of \$32.7 million, or 37.1%, compared to the same time period in 2020 (\$88.3 million). Canada's year-to-date wholesale sales increased 17.3% over this time period.
