Wholesale Trade, June 2020 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – August 19, 2020

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for June 2020 was \$17.0 million. This represents an increase of \$1.3 million, or 8.0%, compared to June 2019, and an increase of \$3.2 million, or 23.4%, compared to May 2020.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in June 2020 increased 2.9% compared to June 2019, and increased 22.5% compared to May 2020.

On a year-to-date basis (January to June), wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$76.1 million. This represents a decrease of \$3.6 million, or 4.5%, compared to the same time period in 2019 (\$79.6 million). Canada's year-to-date wholesale sales decreased 6.3% over this time period.
