



Wholesale Trade, June 2021 *(preliminary)*

Released by Statistics Canada – August 16, 2021

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for June 2021 was \$20.7 million. This represents an increase of \$5.1 million, or 32.4%, compared to June 2020, and an increase of \$555,000, or 2.8%, compared to May 2021.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in June 2021 increased 14.7% compared to June 2020, and increased 2.9% compared to May 2021.

On a year-to-date basis (January to June), wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$97.0 million. This represents an increase of \$23.3 million, or 31.6%, compared to the same time period in 2020 (\$73.7 million). Canada's year-to-date wholesale sales increased 19.4% over this time period.
