# Wholesale Trade, March 2020 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada — May 20, 2020

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for March 2020 was \$14.4 million. This represents a decrease of \$5.4 million, or 27.2%, compared to March 2019, and an increase of \$5.3 million, or 57.4%, compared to February 2020.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in March 2020 increased 1.2% compared to March 2019, and increased 15.0% compared to February 2020.

On a year-to-date basis (January to March), wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$31.8 million. This represents a decrease of \$2.9 million, or 8.3%, compared to the same time period in 2019 (\$34.7 million). Canada's year-to-date wholesale sales increased 3.1% over this time period.
