



Wholesale Trade, March 2021 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – May 14, 2021

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for March 2021 was \$19.5 million. This represents an increase of \$4.9 million, or 33.3%, compared to March 2020, and an increase of \$7.5 million, or 61.8%, compared to February 2021.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in March 2021 increased 16.0% compared to March 2020, and increased 28.2% compared to February 2021.

On a year-to-date basis (January to March), wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$41.5 million. This represents an increase of \$9.0 million, or 27.7%, compared to the same time period in 2020 (\$32.5 million). Canada's year-to-date wholesale sales increased 7.7% over this time period.

On a *revised* annual basis, wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$153.0 million in 2020. Yukon's annual wholesale sales in 2020 decreased by \$732,000, or 0.5%, compared to 2019 (\$153.7 million). Canada's annual wholesale sales decreased 1.0% over this time period.
