

Wholesale Trade, May 2020 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – July 17, 2020

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for May 2020 was \$13.4 million. This represents a decrease of \$2.1 million, or 13.5%, compared to May 2019, and an increase of \$886,000, or 7.1%, compared to April 2020.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in May 2020 decreased 21.9% compared to May 2019, and increased 9.5% compared to April 2020.

On a year-to-date basis (January to May), wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$57.4 million. This represents a decrease of \$6.2 million, or 9.7%, compared to the same time period in 2019 (\$63.5 million). Canada's year-to-date wholesale sales decreased 8.5% over this time period.
