



Wholesale Trade, November 2020 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – January 19, 2021

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for November 2020 was \$9.8 million. This represents an increase of \$2.5 million, or 33.8%, compared to November 2019, and a decrease of \$2.5 million, or 20.2%, compared to October 2020.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in November 2020 increased 6.6% compared to November 2019, and decreased 5.1% compared to October 2020.

On a year-to-date basis (January to November), wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$147.8 million. This represents an increase of \$3.1 million, or 2.2%, compared to the same time period in 2019 (\$144.7 million). Canada's year-to-date wholesale sales decreased 1.7% over this time period.
