

Wholesale Trade, October 2019 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada — December 19, 2019

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for October 2019 was \$17.5 million. This represents a decrease of \$8.7 million, or 33.2%, compared to October 2018, and an increase of \$1.4 million, or 8.6%, compared to September 2019.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in October 2019 increased 1.2% compared to October 2018, and increased 5.9% compared to September 2019.

On a year-to-date basis (January to October), wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$142.2 million. This represents a decrease of \$40.6 million, or 22.2%, compared to the same time period in 2018 (\$182.9 million). Canada's year-to-date wholesale sales increased 2.5% over this time period.
