

Wholesale Trade, September 2021 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – November 15, 2021

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for September 2021 was \$17.4 million. This represents an increase of \$1.8 million, or 11.8%, compared to September 2020, and a decrease of \$2.4 million, or 12.2%, compared to August 2021.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in September 2021 increased 7.2% compared to September 2020, and increased 4.1% compared to August 2021.

On a year-to-date basis (January to September), wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$153.9 million. This represents an increase of \$35.9 million, or 30.4%, compared to the same time period in 2020 (\$118.0 million). Canada's year-to-date wholesale sales increased 15.2% over this time period.
