
Labour Force Survey, August 2019

Released by Statistics Canada — September 6, 2019

In August 2019, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 2.7%. Canada's unemployment rate for August was 5.7%. Compared to the figures for July 2019, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (22,600) decreased by 200; the number of employed (22,000) remained the same; and the number of unemployed (600) decreased by 100.
