

Retail Trade, July 2019 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada — September 20, 2019

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) for retail sales in Yukon for July 2019 was \$83.9 million, an increase of \$4.0 million, or 5.1%, compared to July 2018. The July 2019 retail sales figure increased by \$2.0 million, or 2.4%, compared to June 2019.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 3.0% in July 2019 compared to July 2018, and remained almost unchanged compared to June 2019.

On a year-to-date basis (January to July), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$489.0 million. This represents an increase of \$16.8 million, or 3.6%, compared to the same time period in 2018 (\$472.2 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales increased 1.8% over this time period.
