NUMBER OF LICENSED PREMISES IN THE AREA: Currently there are 40 Food Primary – All Liquor licences and 7 Room Service Licences in the Whitehorse area. The closest Premises that holds a Food Primary – All Liquor licence is the Woodcutter's Blanket, located approximately 300 meters south, at the corner of Strickland Street and 2nd Avenue. The Closest Premises that holds a Room Service licence is the Westmark Hotel, which is located approximately 500 meters away, at the corner of Wood Street and 2nd Avenue.

ISSUE CONSIDERATIONS:

A.) STRUCTURE/PREMISES:

The premises is under construction, with completion expected to be within approximately 1 year. The completed project will see a 5-storey hotel and suites located at 150 Keish Street, or the corner of Keish Street and 2nd Avenue. This is adjacent to Lumel Studios, which is also located on Keish St.

The hotel will include a Restaurant in its lobby that is separated into two areas. The hotel would also like to offer room service from the restaurant.

B.) MENU:

The menu includes such items as breakfast, soups, salads and sandwiches.

C.) HOURS OF BUSINESS & HOURS OF LIQUOR SERVICE:

The business hours are 6:00 AM – 2:00 AM with liquor service hours being 9:00 AM – 2:00 AM, 7 days a week.
