Decision of the Yukon Liquor Board

ITEM # 20-04

The Yukon Liquor Board approves the application for Lem-2 Company Limited, operating as 98 Hotel, for changes to an existing Liquor Primary – All Liquor Licence and Off Premises Liquor Licence which includes an extension of hours, and renovations to the licensed area resulting in an increase to existing floor space and capacity, providing that all the requirements of the *Liquor Act* and Regulations have been met.

Condition:

- 1) A licensed establishment holding an Off Premises Licence must be open for business for a period of four (4) consecutive hours during the period of time specified on the Liquor Primary and/or Food Primary license(s) held by the establishment.

The Yukon Liquor Board approves the application for Lem-2 Company Limited, operating as 98 Hotel, for cancellation of Off Premises Beer / Wine Licence, providing that all the requirements of the *Liquor Act* and Regulations have been met.

This decision is based on the application as presented to board, and relevant sections of the *Liquor Act* and Regulations and board policy.
