Decision of the Yukon Liquor Board

ITEM # 20-12

The Yukon Liquor Board approves the application for 46139 Inc., o/a Caribou Crossing Trading Post, for an Off-Premises Liquor licence providing that all the requirements of the Liquor Act and Regulations have been met. This decision of the Yukon Liquor Board was made with consideration of density and proximity policy and in the absence of public opposition.

Condition:

1) A licensed establishment holding an Off Premises licence must be open for business for a period of four (4) consecutive hours during the period of time specified on the Liquor Primary and/or Food Primary license(s) held by the establishment.
