Decision of the Yukon Liquor Board

ITEM # 20-12

The Yukon Liquor Board approves the application for 46139 Inc., o/a Caribou Crossing Trading Post, for an Off-Premises Liquor licence providing that all the requirements of the *Liquor Act* and Regulations have been met. This decision of the Yukon Liquor Board was made with consideration of density and proximity policy and in the absence of public opposition.

Condition:

- 1) A licensed establishment holding an Off Premises licence must be open for business for a period of four (4) consecutive hours during the period of time specified on the Liquor Primary and/or Food Primary license(s) held by the establishment.

This decision is based on the application as presented to board, and relevant sections of the *Liquor Act* and Regulations and board policy.
