**Decision of the Yukon Liquor Board** 

ITEM # 20-17

The Yukon Liquor Board denies the application for 16714 Yukon Inc., operating as G&P Steakhouse for an Off Premises Liquor Licence based on board policy manual Off-Premises Liquor Licence tab 7, which states, "minimum of one-hundred and fifty (150) meters away from a public park, school, daycare, youth center, alcohol/treatment facility, existing off-sales licensee, YLC Store, or other areas considered by the board to pose a potential conflict, including those frequented by children, youth or other vulnerable persons." The board finds the application for an Off Premises Liquor Licence falls within the proximity of 1 existing licensee who holds an off premises license.

This decision is based on the application as presented to board, and relevant sections of the Liquor Act and Regulations and board policy.
